Foreword

To the best of our knowledge, the website generally fulfils the requirements of WCAG 2.1 at level AA. The following measures have been implemented:

- The contrasts between the font colours and the background correspond to the recommended WCAG values (e. g. $\geq 4.5 : 1$) via plugin control.

- The focus states are clearly visible.
- The users can navigate forwards and backwards through the content using the keyboard.

Understandable (Guideline 3.x)

- The language of the site is German (de-DE) and is correctly declared.

Robust (Guideline 4.x)

- The HTML/CSS structure is compliant with the standards, and the ARIA attributes are used correctly.
- The contents are compatible with various browsers and aids.
